Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) – Beijing, China

Today you'll depart Australia (or New Zealand) for Beijing, China. Upon arrival, a tour representative will meet you at the airport and transfer you to the hotel.

Beijing is the monumental capital of China, blending over three millennia of history with dynamic, ultra-modern architecture. As the political and cultural heart of the country, it offers visitors an incredible juxtaposition where ancient alleys stand alongside gleaming skyscrapers.

Please note:

- *Some travellers may depart on Day 0.*
- *Some travellers may have an overnight layover with accommodation and transfers provided.*
- *Some travellers may arrive very early in the morning of Day 2.*

Day 2 Tiananmen Square & Forbidden City (or Tiananmen Square & Temple of Heaven)

After breakfast this morning, visit Tiananmen Square, one of the largest public squares in the world which serves as the symbolic and geographical heart of Beijing and hosts some of the country's most important architectural monuments, governmental buildings, and museums.

Next, you'll see the Imperial Palace in the Forbidden City. The Forbidden City, known officially as The Palace Museum, was originally constructed by Emperor Yong Le who was the third Emperor of the Ming Dynasty. The palace was built between

1406 and 1420 but has been rebuilt and renovated countless times, so most of the architecture you can see today dates from the 1700s and onwards.

Afterwards you will have the opportunity to take part in an optional activity, or explore Beijing at leisure.

Optional Activity: Summer Palace and Beijing Zoo with Dinner

Take a trip to the majestic Summer Palace, a beautiful UNESCO World Heritage site and a masterpiece of Chinese landscape garden design. The natural landscape of hills and open water is combined with artificial features such as pavilions, halls, palaces, temples and bridges to form a harmonious ensemble of outstanding aesthetic value.

Then head to the Panda House, the crown jewel of Beijing Zoo. Since the successful captive breeding of the first giant panda in 1963, and the world's first successful artificial insemination in 1978, the zoo has been at the forefront of panda conservation. Finish with a delicious dinner experience that will allow you to savour authentic regional flavours. Not included, paid on tour. Please see current pricing in Important Information.

- *The Temple of Heaven, founded in the first half of the 15th century, is a dignified complex of fine cult buildings that are set in gardens and surrounded by historic pine woods. In its overall layout, it symbolises the relationship between earth and heaven which stands at the heart of Chinese cosmogony and also recognises the special role played by the emperors within that relationship.*

Overnight: Beijing Meida Hotel or similar

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 3 Great Wall of China

After breakfast, you'll travel to a Jade museum and factory to learn the history of jade, observe skilled artisans at work as they create their intricate designs and shop for a souvenir. In Chinese, jade is pronounced as "Yu" and has a history of at least four thousand years in China. Then take a scenic drive through the countryside and mountains to reach China's most renowned monument, the Great Wall. Along the way, you'll enjoy a picnic lunch.

On arrival at the Great Wall, visit the less-touristy and more original Juyong Pass, avoiding other sections that are the most accessible and consequently, the most crowded. The Great Wall meanders through China's northern mountain ranges from the Yellow Sea to the Gobi Desert which is a distance of more than 5,600 kilometres. Afterwards return to Beijing where you may take part in an optional activity, or explore Beijing at leisure.

Optional Activity: Hutong Pedicab Tour & Dinner

In the afternoon, take the opportunity to join an optional tour (not included, paid on tour) of Beijing's 700-year-old Hutongs (narrow lanes) area by old-fashioned pedicab. Visit a local family

to experience the local customs and enjoy a delicious home-cooked dinner. The optional tour also includes visiting Shichahai, a historic scenic area consisting of three lakes (Qianhai, Houhai and Xihai) which surround places of historic interest, scenic beauty and remnants of old-style hutong and courtyard local residences. Day 4 Beijing – Shanghai - Suzhou

After breakfast, head to a traditional Chinese health centre where you'll learn about acupuncture, herbal medicine and other wellness practices integral to Traditional Chinese Medicine. Travel to the airport for your onward flight to Shanghai where, upon arrival, a tour representative will meet you and transfer you to Suzhou. Then check into your hotel for an evening at leisure after an approximately 110-kilometre travel day.

Often called the 'Venice of the East', Suzhou is one of China's most historic and culturally rich cities, celebrated for its elegant stone bridges, tranquil canal networks, exquisite silk industry, and UNESCO-listed classical gardens.

Day 5 Suzhou – Wuxi

This morning you will visit the famous UNESCO-listed Lingering Garden before stopping by a silk spinning factory as China is renowned for its exquisite silk. Afterwards enjoy time at leisure or take part in an optional activity.

Optional Activity: Grand Canal Cruise

Take the opportunity to cruise along the Grand Canal to view life along China's ancient waterway. In the afternoon, you'll drive approximately 40 kilometres to nearby Wuxi. Known as the 'Land of Fish and Rice', Wuxi is a captivating cultural hub in Jiangsu Province nestled right along the shores of Lake Tai (Taihu). On arrival visit Lihu Park, a serene oasis nestled along the picturesque shores of Lake Lihu. This is where you'll find lush

greenery, scenic walking paths and charming bridges so make time to admire the peaceful views as you spot locals cycling around the lake, fishing and boating along the water.

Day 6 Wuxi - Hangzhou

Wuxi is also known as the 'Bright Pearl of Taihu Lake', as it is a major hub for high-quality freshwater pearls. Cultivated in the nutrient-rich waters of Lake Tai, these pearls are prized globally for their impressive luster, color range, and variety. This morning, you'll gain an insight into China's enormous manufacturing and production capabilities by visiting a Pearl Factory & shop to learn about freshwater pearls, a key export commodity with great cultural significance since the Han dynasty. Afterwards, you'll drive approximately 200 kilometres to Hangzhou where you can check into your hotel for an evening at leisure.

Celebrated for centuries as 'Heaven on Earth', Hangzhou is one of China's most beautiful and storied cities. The city centers around the legendary, willow-lined West Lake, rolling green tea hills, and misty Buddhist temples. It offers a much softer, more romantic pace than neighboring Shanghai, which is just an hour away via high-speed train.

Day 7 Hangzhou - Shanghai

Hangzhou is considered one of the tea capitals of China, so a visit to the city just isn't complete without a trip to a local tea house. Today you'll make a special visit to the Tea House at Meijiawu Tea Village, located in the hinterland of West Lake Park which is considered one of the most important Longjing Tea productions in China. This is your chance to enjoy the natural environment and beautiful village scenery while learning more about their special tea culture. At the Tea House, you'll learn how to make Longjing Tea including picking, frying and tasting the tea leaves.

Afterwards, enjoy a short boat ride on the UNESCO-listed West Lake where you can marvel at the ethereal beauty of Hangzhou's willow-draped islands. Then drive approximately 175 kilometres to Shanghai Shanghai serves as China's financial capital and premier global megacity. Situated at the mouth of the Yangtze River, it is bisected by the Huangpu River into historic Puxi on the west bank and futuristic Pudong on the east. Known historically as the "Paris of the East," it seamlessly blends classical Chinese traditions with European colonial architecture and high-tech urban design.

On arrival in Shanghai, visit the famous Bund, a five-block riverfront promenade with many of Shanghai's banks and trading houses. You'll discover that Shanghai is divided by the Huangpu River with modern mega-high rises on the eastern side and

traditional European-style architecture on the western side. Afterwards you may take part in an optional activity, or explore Shanghai at leisure.

Optional Activity: ERA & The Intersection of Time

Tonight, take part in an optional activity to watch a superb and thrilling Chinese Acrobatic Show, "ERA: The Intersection of Time" or similar. Not included, paid on tour. Please see current pricing in Important Information.

While tipping is not mandatory, it is a common practice in China and a gesture of appreciation which is shared amongst the local guides, drivers and other staff members who have serviced your tour. The tipping amount can be paid in AUD or RMB to your expert tour guide in each region. As most tour guides in China consider tipping a part of their income, please don't feel intimidated should the tour guides approach you as they bid you farewell.

Other Important Information

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour

guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Spring (March - May)

Beijing

Spring in Beijing arrives with a rapid rise in temperature but is often accompanied by strong winds and very dry conditions. Temperatures typically range from about 8 degrees Celsius to 22 degrees Celsius. The early part of the season can feel chilly and is occasionally prone to dust storms rolling in from the Gobi Desert. As the season progresses into May, the weather becomes warm and pleasant, offering a popular time to see spring blooms before the summer heat.

Shanghai

Spring in Shanghai is warm and fresh, characterized by blooming flowers and fluctuating weather. Temperatures generally range from about 11 degrees Celsius to 21 degrees Celsius, with early mornings feeling cool and afternoons becoming pleasantly warm. Light rain showers and frequent drizzles are common during this transition period. Overall, it is considered an excellent time for tourism and outdoor activities before the summer humidity arrives.

Summer (June - August)

Beijing

Summer in Beijing is hot, humid, and marks the peak rainy season for the region. Temperatures frequently range between

25 degrees Celsius and 35 degrees Celsius, with intense heatwaves occasionally pushing afternoon highs above 38 degrees Celsius. Heavy downpours and sudden thunderstorms are common, especially in July and August, providing brief relief from the stifling urban heat. The high humidity can make midday outdoor excursions challenging.

Shanghai

Summer in Shanghai is notoriously hot and sticky due to its subtropical climate and high humidity. Temperatures typically range from 26 degrees Celsius to 32 degrees Celsius, but often climb above 35 degrees Celsius during peak periods. The city experiences the plum rain season in early summer, bringing prolonged overcast skies and heavy precipitation, followed by late summer typhoon risks that can bring sudden storms and strong winds.

Autumn (September - November)

Beijing

Autumn is widely considered the most comfortable and beautiful season to visit Beijing. The intense summer heat breaks quickly, giving way to crisp, clear skies and very pleasant weather. Temperatures generally range from 10 degrees Celsius to 25 degrees Celsius in early autumn, cooling down sharply by November. The humidity drops significantly, leaving the city dry and sunny, which is perfect for outdoor sightseeing.

Shanghai

Autumn in Shanghai is a highly favored season due to its comfortable and moderate conditions. The sweltering summer heat recedes as temperatures gradually cool down from around 25 degrees Celsius in September to about 15 degrees Celsius by late November. The humidity drops noticeably, and the city enjoys clearer, breezier days with less rainfall compared to the summer months, making it ideal for walking tours.

Luggage:

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on tour. You must carry your own luggage from the vehicle to the hotel room and back to the vehicle. The driver will assist with the uploading and unloading of bags from the vehicle.

OTHER

Fitness Level Required:

Adventure (and spontaneity) create some of the best travel memories. Bear in mind, your home schedules and timings might not be adhered to on tour - it's all part of the fun!

A moderate level of fitness will be required.

This journey requires a moderate level of physical fitness. - *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
