Gratuities (tips) are not included for the services of the tour leader (when available) and driver throughout the tour. The recommended tip is \$5 per person per day. This covers the guide/leader and the driver and will be collected on tour.

Please note: Tipping for services provided is always a matter of personal discretion; however, please be aware that many locals consider tipping part of their normal remuneration, and they may approach you for payment; there's no need to be intimidated by the request.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or

village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES
Norfolk Island, located in the South Pacific Ocean, has a subtropical climate with mild temperatures throughout the year. The climate on Norfolk Island can be generally described as pleasant and moderate, making it a popular destination.

Summer (December to February):

Summer on Norfolk Island is warm and humid.

Average high temperatures range from 24°C to 28°C.

It is the wettest season with occasional heavy rainfall and thunderstorms.

Autumn (March to May):

Autumn is characterized by mild and pleasant weather.

Average high temperatures range from 22°C to 25°C.

Rainfall decreases as the season progresses, with March being relatively wetter than May.

Winter (June to August):

Winter on Norfolk Island is cool and relatively dry.

Average high temperatures range from 18°C to 20°C.

Nighttime temperatures can drop, and it's the least humid season.

Spring (September to November):

Spring is a pleasant and transitional period with increasing warmth and greenery.

Average high temperatures range from 20°C to 23°C.
