Port Everglades houses a buzzing cultural hub, including several fascinating museums such as The Museum of Discovery & Science and the NSU Art Museum. Take a trip back in time at The Bonnet House Museum and Gardens, an ornate plantation-style mansion with 35 acres of stunning estate grounds and an impressive art collection housed within.

You could take a trip to the bustling metropolitan city of Miami, around 45 minutes away by car. There you can sample a rich Cuban coffee as you stroll around Little Havana, maybe paying a visit to the Maximo Gomez Park and Calle Ocho Walk of Fame. Admire the iconic Art Deco flair of the buildings around Miami's famous South Beach or perhaps come face-to-face with wild animals at one of Miami's numerous animal parks.

Forming a British Overseas Territory, this archipelago consists of around 40 low-lying islands southeast of the Bahamas.

Grand Turk is the second most populated, even at scarcely seven square miles. The oldest known residents were the Arawak-speaking Taino people, and it is believed they traded salt which formed naturally when the seawater entered shallow inland ponds and evaporated in the sun. Indeed, British colonists from Bermuda arrived in the late seventeenth century to collect the salt, and they modified the system.

There's still plenty of evidence of the low stone walls used to compartment off the salt pans across the islands, not least at the Salt House museum next to Town Salina.

Day 13 Fortaleza, Brazil

On the north shore of Brazil's 'shoulder,' Fortaleza is a pleasant palm-lined city and the capital of the Ceara state. It looks out into the Atlantic from a long stretch of beautiful, sandy coast.

The first European settlers here were Dutch, and they built the five-pointed, star-shaped Fort Shoonenborch in 1649 after defeat at the hands of local people and the Portuguese.

In 1654, the Dutch left, and the fort was renamed Fortaleza de Nossa Senhora da Assuncao; the area around it was to grow into Brazil's fifth largest city. The citadel itself remains, its low-rise whitewashed walls adorned with cannons and palm trees.

As the oceans mingle, they create powerful currents that, depending on the time of year, can produce both spectacular waves and mysteriously calm waters. It's a unique experience that you'll no doubt recount to friends for years to come.

Day 34 Punta Arenas, Chile

Punta Arenas is the official gateway to the Chilean Patagonia.

From the dramatic backdrop of the Andes Mountains to the penguin colonies of Magdalena Island, there's no shortage of natural splendour to behold on a cruise to Punta Arenas.

Located at the southern tip of Chile, this vibrant city is home to a unique blend of Chilean and European cultures. You'll see this reflected in the picturesque mix of buildings lining the bustling city streets, as well as the museums and galleries seeded throughout town. Venturing just a short distance beyond the city immerses you in breathtaking scenery, making Punta Arenas a perfect destination for nature lovers and urban explorers alike.

Day 35 Amalia Glacier, Chile (Scenic Cruising)

Sailing the Amalia Glacier is your unique journey into Chile's pristine wilderness of sparkling waters, snow-capped peaks, majestic forests, and spectacular blue-tinged glaciers.

The soothing silence is interrupted only by the occasional warble of a cormorant as you glide through narrow fjords, passing towering ice-flows and snow-dusted mountaintops.

Sometimes called Skua Glacier, Amalia is a tidewater glacier, meaning that it flows through a valley and ends in the ocean. It is located in Bernardo O'Higgins National Park, which is the largest protected area in Chile, named after the republic's first head of state.

Cruising past the glacier will allow passengers to see it up close and take in the rugged ice's majestic beauty.

Glacier ice is unlike regular ice, stretching and bending instead of shattering and breaking and, perhaps most strikingly, has a bright blue appearance. This is because the sheer weight of a glacial mass means that the bubbles of air that are normally present in ice are compressed out of it, making it more dense and lending it that brilliant blue colour.

Lucky passengers may be able to spot wildlife during their Amalia Glacier cruise. Curious dolphins can often be seen frolicking alongside the ship, and cormorants look down on the stunning scene from the air. This natural habitat is also home to otters and the Andean condor, which is part of the vulture family.

Pío XI Glacier in the Chilean fjords is the only glacier that is growing rather than shrinking. Its frontage stretches over two miles, and you may see and hear huge chunks of ice calving into the sea.

Day 38 Puerto Montt, Chile

Standing almost at the halfway point of Chile's famously long coastline, Puerto Montt is the gateway to the country's Lake District. National parks, glacial lakes, and mountain ranges are just some of the stunning natural scenery you can explore on a voyage here. In addition, Puerto Montt boasts a rich German heritage, with notable German-style architecture and influences.

Lying at the head of Reloncaví Sound / Bay, Puerto Montt is a bustling centre of fishing and agriculture, wrapped in the culture and architecture left behind by early German settlers. Named in honour of Chilean president Jose Manuel Montt, Puerto Montt's German influences are so ingrained that stepping ashore here can easily feel as though you've arrived in Bavaria. A picture of Chilean-German charm, the city's architecture, lakes, and narrow fjords will have you reaching for your camera time and again.

Day 40 San Antonio (Santiago), Chile (Overnight)

In the Chilean capital, grand colonial buildings stand proudly among glass skyscrapers and elegant parks. In the distance, the snow-dusted Andes provide a dramatic backdrop to it all. Santiago was founded in 1541 by the Spanish conquistador Pedro de Valdivia. It's been Chile's first city since its colonial days, and the central district is a hub of nineteenth-century neoclassical architecture.

An obvious starting point is Plaza de Armas, with its twin-spired Metropolitan Cathedral, the magnificent Correo Central, which was the old city post office, and the National Museum of History, whose bell tower offers an elevated viewpoint. It was always intended to be a focal point, and a hive of activity still unfolds around the statues and fountains. Local chess players pit their wits against each other on many afternoons, street performers attract crowds with their routines, and you may even see demonstrations of the Cueca, Chile's national folk dance.

Please note: San Antonio is roughly 115 kilometres (a 1.5-hour drive) from Santiago and 80 kilometres from Valparaíso.

Day 41 San Antonio (Santiago), Chile

When you berth in San Antonio, you're also only around 40 miles from Valparaíso. The port has won plenty of admirers for its rolling hills, where steep funiculars climb among the charming jumble of multi-coloured houses, and its historic quarter has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2003.

Santiago has its scenic spots too, not least the Cerro San Cristóbal. It's one of the 'island hills', and you can understand what that means once you've ridden the funicular up almost 1,000 feet and look down over the sea of buildings and parks laid out below. Here you'll share the view with a statue of the Virgin Mary, some 2,800 feet above sea level. Another scenic spot is the Cerro Santa Lucía, with its beautifully terraced gardens looking across to the Andes.

Welcome to up-and-coming Coquimbo. Halfway down the long strip that is Chile, this working port city on the Pan American Highway is making a name for itself, especially when it comes to the nightlife. The elegant 19th-century English Quarter is beautiful by day, whereas the Aldunate area is where to be at night, full of bars and nightclubs where you can watch or partake in South American dancing. Stroll the fish market along Coquimbo Bay or the fishing jetty for some delicious fresh seafood with a glass of pisco, the hand-distilled pisco spirit made from the muscatel grapes of the Elqui Valley, mixed with cola.

Day 45 Arica, Chile

As well as being blessed with amazing archaeological treasures, including the oldest mummies in the world, Arica attracts international acclaim for its fine wines and truly world-class surfing waves. Known by Chileans as 'city of the eternal spring', Arica has been an important port since Spanish colonial rule in the 1500s, and has plenty to offer in terms of historic sites and places to visit. With warm, dry summers and long, cool winters, the city's delicious and imaginative cuisine reflects the abundance of fresh, local ingredients from the exotic fruit-filled valleys and olive groves of Azapa and Lluta.

Day 47 Callao (Lima), Peru (Overnight)

To the conquistadores, this was the 'City of Kings' and its colonial majesty still dominates the heart of Peru's capital. Dramatic cliffs, golden beaches and varied cuisine are among its other riches. An undoubted highlight of Lima is the Plaza Mayor in its centre. It's filled with grand colonial buildings, some of which date from the 16th century, such as The Government Palace, which occupies almost the whole north side of the square. Other impressive landmarks include the Archbishop's Palace and the twin-towered baroque cathedral.

We strongly suggest you contact the airline directly with seating allocation requirements and/or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating. While we do not add frequent flyer member details to bookings, you can do this directly with the airline once you have your flight information.

Dietary Requests

Meal options and availability differ between airlines and routes therefore not all dietary requests can be accommodated. If your flight includes meals we will select the most suitable option available based on the dietary requirements you have specified. All meal requests are subject to airline approval and are not guaranteed, therefore we recommend preparing for your flight by bringing appropriate food for yourself, as required.

Passport Validity:

Customers must provide valid passport details either at the time of purchase or no later than 90 days before the departure date. Failure to do so may result in the cancellation of the booking. Customers will be responsible for any costs and fees

incurred in this instance.

CRUISE

Embarkation / Disembarkation:

- Begins approximately 2 hours after docking.
- Due to security reasons, all guests must be on board 2 hours before sailing.
- Itineraries are subject to change at any time without notice.
- Check your specific sailing for exact departure and arrival times. All times are local to the port.

Please note: Travellers must contact the cruise line directly upon receiving their travel documents in order to request any membership benefits they may be entitled to.

COACH TOUR

Meals:

For meals not included, the tour leader (when available) will offer assistance with reservations, suggestions and directions to local restaurants. It is your responsibility to notify us of any dietary requests/requirements.

Please note: We will do our best to meet your requests/requirements; however, we cannot guarantee that we will always be able to.

Luggage:

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on tour. You must carry your own luggage from the vehicle to the hotel room and back to the vehicle. The driver will assist with the uploading and unloading of bags from the vehicle.

Mobility:

Fitness Level Required:

It is expected that every traveller must be self-reliant and able to undertake all aspects of their own travel. Please speak to your booking agent about your personal circumstances and any assistance requirements to ensure this tour is right for you.

Yellow Fever:

A valid international certificate of vaccination against Yellow Fever is required in many countries. You may need to present this on arrival at the airport or border crossing. Some countries will refuse entry if you are unable to present your certificate. It's also common for your home country to request a Yellow Fever certificate upon arrival.

You must check with your doctor well before leaving home about the Yellow Fever requirements for the countries you'll be visiting.

Visas

United States of America

An ESTA (Visa Waiver) for the USA is a strict requirement when travelling to or flying through the USA. Once a USA ESTA Visa Waiver is issued, it is valid for 2 years or until your passport expires (whichever is sooner) and will allow multiple entries into the USA. For information on ESTA eligibility or to apply, please visit:

Please note: Due to recent changes in the USA Immigration policies, TripADeal recommend all travellers visit US Customs & Border Protection.

Canada (If transiting)

If transiting via Canada on the way to the USA, Australian and New Zealand passport holders must apply for an electronic travel authorisation (eTA) before travelling to Canada by air. An Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) is an entry requirement for visa-exempt foreign nationals travelling to Canada by air. An eTA is electronically linked to a traveller's passport. It is valid for up to five years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first. If you get a new passport, you need to get a new eTA.

Turks & Caicos Islands

Australian passport holders do not need a visa to visit the Turks and Caicos Islands for stays of up to 90 days. Your passport must be valid for at least six months beyond your intended departure date and have at least two blank visa pages.

Barbados

Australian passport holders do not need a tourist visa to enter Barbados for stays of up to 180 days. Hold a passport valid at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page

Brazil

A visa is required for Australian passport holders entering Brazil. Persons travelling after this date to Brazil will require a Visit Visa to enter the country. You can apply for a visa here: <https://www.gov.br/mre/pt-br/embaixada-camberra/English/consular-section/visas/short-term-visas-for-stays-up-to-90-days/e-visa>. Entry and exit conditions may change without warning. Follow the advice of border and health authorities and comply with local regulations. Contact your airline or the nearest embassy or consulate of Brazil for more information.

Uruguay

Australian tourists can enter Uruguay without a visa for up to 90 days. Entry and exit conditions can change at short notice. Contact the nearest embassy or consulate of Uruguay for details about visas, currency, customs and other travel requirements.

Argentina

As a tourist, you can stay for up to 90 days without a visa, but you'll need:

- A return or onward ticket.
- A valid passport.
- Travel/medical insurance.

Please Note: Effective immediately, all international travellers to Argentina must hold valid travel insurance with medical coverage.

This insurance may be requested and verified upon arrival in the country.

Argentina's public healthcare system will no longer provide free medical services to foreign nationals. It is therefore essential that you obtain appropriate insurance before your departure.

Chile

As of 17th September 2025, tourist visas for Chile are not required if travelling on an Australian Passport. You can stay in Chile for up to 90 days without a visa. If you're unsure whether you need a visa, contact the nearest embassy or consulate of Chile.

Peru

Tourists who hold an Australian passport don't need a visa. You can get a permit to stay for up to 3 months when you arrive. You may need a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate to enter Peru. Some airlines may want to see one when you leave. If you've visited Peru in the previous 6 days, you'll need a valid certificate to enter Australia. Find out about returning to Australia after exposure to yellow fever.

Panama

If you're transiting on a cruise ship and Panama is a port of call, you won't need a visa. An immigration official will stamp your passport, and you'll be granted a stay of up to 90 days. Make sure your passport is stamped on entry to Panama. You may face a fine up to \$US1,000 and delays if you fail to present an entry-stamped passport when departing Panama.

Aruba

Australian citizens visiting Aruba on a cruise do not need a visa for stays under 90 days. You simply need an Australian passport valid for the duration of your stay and your cruise ID/boarding pass when you step off the ship in Oranjestad

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*



Important Information

- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
 - *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
 - *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
 - *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
- If the incorrect name has been provided, charges of \$100 per booking and any additional charges applied by the airline/ cruise company/accommodation/other travel providers.
