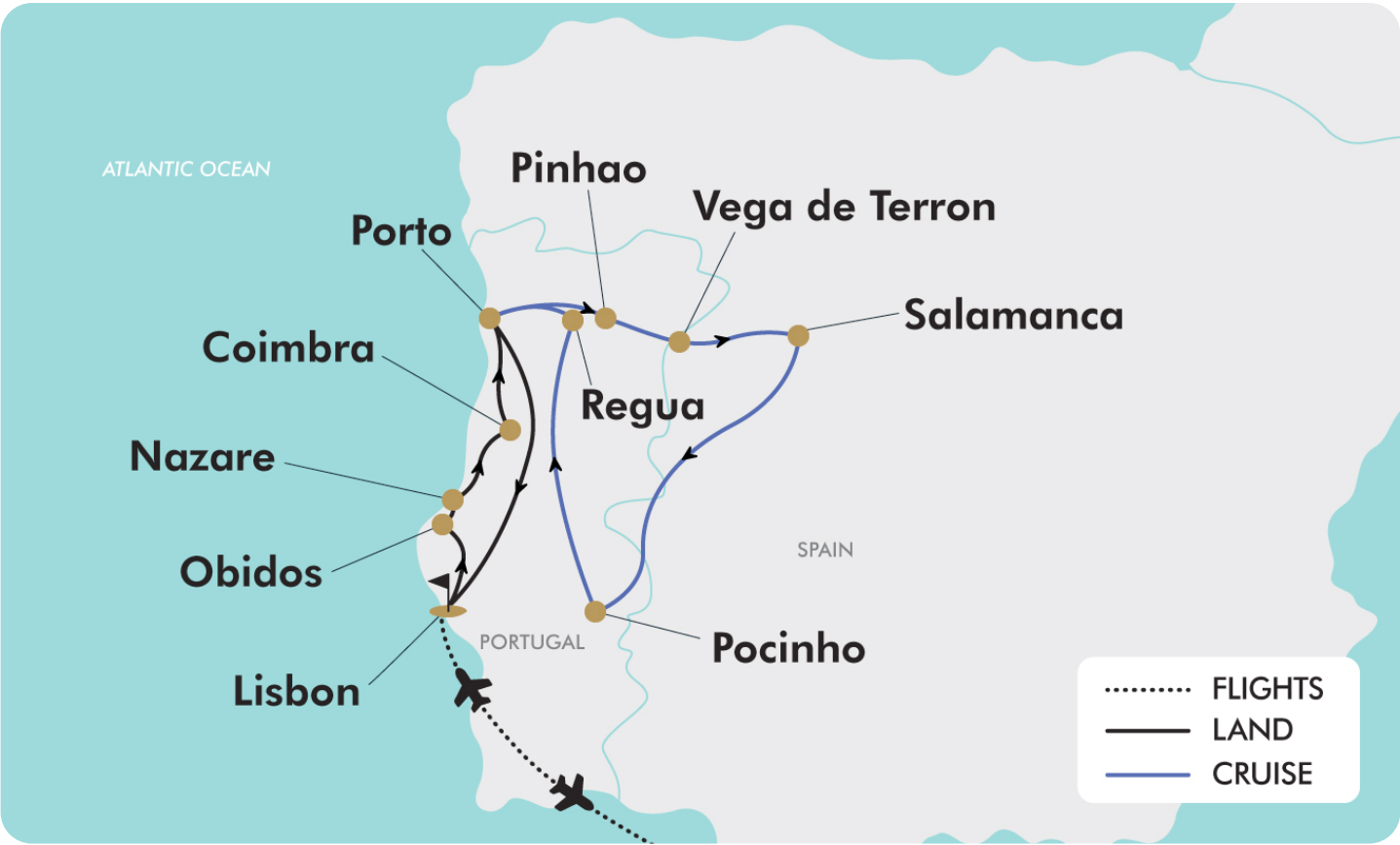

Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Lisbon, Portugal

Today depart for vibrant Lisbon, Portugal!

Today enjoy a half-day guided tour of Lisbon. Wander through the maze-like streets to reach the main attractions. See Lisbon's Cathedral and Casa dos Bicos, the old city's pastel-coloured buildings, Tagus Estuary and the Ponte 25 de Abril suspension bridge.

Afterwards, enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Day 4 Lisbon – Obidos – Nazare – Coimbra – Porto

Today, travel to the west of Portugal, to explore coastal Nazare, known worldwide for having the biggest waves on earth and a unique cultural fishing heritage. Discover Sitio, a historic cliffside neighbourhood perched 110 metres above the beach with views from Church of Our Lady of Nazare (entry not included).

Afterwards continue to Obidos, a walled medieval town, to visit picturesque streets and the castle. The main pedestrian street is lined with whitewashed houses, bright bougainvillea flowers, bakeries and craft shops. The town is famous for ginjinha, a sweet cherry liqueur. Local shops often serve the drink in small, edible dark chocolate cups.

Then, head to Coimbra, famous for its UNESCO-Listed ancient university and charming medieval streets. The historic centre has steep, narrow streets; cobblestone alleys that wind down from the university into the town centre.

In the late afternoon, arrive in beautiful Porto, the second largest city in Portugal. Known for Port wine and the Douro River, this is a vibrant city with a huge cultural and artistic life, where every corner offers something amazing to see and experience.

Upon arrival check in to your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Hotel Vila Gale, Porto or similar

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 5 Porto - Begin 7 Night Porto River Cruise

This morning enjoy time at leisure in Porto's pastel-coloured metropolis.

Day 7 Pinhao, Portugal – Vega de Terron, Spain

Pinhao (pronounced 'Pin-yow'), just a few hours from Porto, is a tiny village in the heart of the Douro Valley, surrounded by vineyards and beautiful countryside. Enjoy this hidden gem, sip local Port wine, explore hiking trails or relax and soak up the charms of Portugal.

Included Excursion

Visit The Beautiful Quinta do Tedo Vineyard

Set on the hills surrounding the confluence of the Douro and Tedo rivers, this 18th-century estate is environmentally sound, creating organic produce using traditional viticulture methods. Enjoy tasting their famous Port wine and learning about blending of traditional viticulture methods with modern technology to create a seamless process. Alternatively, join a guided walk through their vineyards, stopping to admire the beautiful surrounds.

Kayak Experience in Pinhao

Embark on a kayak excursion along the Pinhao River, taking in the impressive views from the heart of the Douro Valley. Glide slowly past patchwork farmland, terraced vineyards and sprawling estates as you traverse this tranquil tributary of the Douro.

Day 8 Vega de Terron, Spain – Salamanca, Spain

Just across the Spanish border, Vega de Terron is at the junction of the Douro and Agueda rivers. It's the gateway to the ancient city of Salamanca, known as the 'Golden City' for its stunning Renaissance architecture built from Villamayor sandstone, which glows golden, pink and ochre at sunrise and sunset.

Included Excursion

Guided Tour of Salamanca

Founded in Roman times, the ancient city of Salamanca and its World Heritage-listed Old Quarter have an illustrious past, having been held by the Carthaginians, Romans and Moors. Set out on a walking tour, which includes exploring the postcard-worthy galleries and arcades that adorn Plaza Mayor. You'll also have the opportunity to see Casa de las Conchas, a building that has been lovingly decorated with more than 300 shells, and Salamanca's university, one of the oldest universities in Europe, dating back to 1218.

Tuna Music Band in Salamanca

The tradition of 'tuna music' dates back to the 13th century, arising from poor university students who would sing in the streets to raise money for their tuition. It showcases a powerful tradition of academic and social life in Spain, with performers dressing in distinctive clothing, including capes with colourful ribbons to represent their school. Enjoy a performance of this unique music from a local group.

Day 9 Pocinho, Portugal – Regua, Portugal

The tiny village of Pocinho is around 30 km from the Spanish border, surrounded by river and mountains. This isolated spot has a small population of just a few hundred people, with its white-walled and red-roofed buildings that blend into the landscape. Nearby, museums and archaeological sites will take you deeper into Portugal's history.

Tour to Castelo Rodrigo

Visit the charming medieval town of Castelo Rodrigo, a small, fortified hilltop village. Uncover the secrets of its history, admire its 16th-century walls and walk down charming, narrow medieval streets. Later, try some typical local products and enjoy some free time to explore on your own.

Return to your Emerald Star-Ship for lunch, then enjoy a Port wine cocktail lesson as you cruise down the river. Day 10 Regua – Porto

Get an insight into Portuguese life in Regua, a busy town that sits at the western edge of the Port wine growing region. It is steeped in winemaking culture and has been an important trading and transport centre since the 18th century. Backed by the stunning Serra do Marao mountains, it promises dramatic scenery and a welcoming atmosphere.

Guided Tour Of Lamego

On today's included excursion, visit the marvellous Baroque village of Lamego, a place that has been shaped by Portugal's devout Catholic faith and centuries of winemaking. Nestled among the terraced slopes of the Douro Valley, the elegant town is infused with Baroque style. Stop to admire the picturesque Shrine of Our Lady of Remedies, a structure that stands gracefully over the town. Its hundreds of zigzagging stairs are decorated with tiled friezes and climb out of a tailored garden resplendent with a variety of trees.

Rural Lunch At A Local Quinta

Enjoy a rural lunch at a local Quinta, a famous wine estate in the Douro, which is certain to be a highlight of your trip. A traditional meal will be served and beautifully accompanied by local entertainment.

This Baroque, zigzag staircase offers spectacular views and is lined with small chapels and shrines dedicated to various saints and martyrs.

Cruise to Porto in the afternoon, to dock overnight, perfect to explore this vibrant city after dark.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Spain:

This trip covers a lot of ground, from the Mediterranean coast to the high central plateau.

Important Information

February – March:

Central Spain/Salamanca: Crisp and dry. Highs of 12°C – 15°C, but nights are cold, often dipping to 1°C – 4°C.

April – June:

The most comfortable time. Temperatures across all three cities range from 18°C to 26°C. Central Spain/Salamanca begins to heat up significantly by late June.

July – August:

Central Spain/Salamanca: Dry, intense heat. Highs often exceed 33°C – 35°C, though low humidity makes it slightly more bearable than the coast.

September – October:

Temperatures retreat to a pleasant 20°C – 25°C.

Portugal

Portugal's weather is heavily influenced by the Atlantic, keeping it slightly cooler and greener than Central Spain/Salamanca.

February – March:

Mild but often damp, especially in the North (Porto). Average highs are 14°C – 17°C, with nights around 8°C.

April – June:

Stunning spring weather. Temperatures sit between 18°C and 23°C. This is the best time for hiking and sightseeing before the summer crowds arrive.

July – August:

Lisbon: Warm to hot, usually 27°C – 30°C. A consistent sea breeze (the Nortada) often keeps the heat from becoming stifling.

Interior: Areas near the Spanish border can spike to 35°C+.

September – October:

A "second summer". September remains warm (25°C), while October brings the start of the rainy season in the north, though temperatures stay mild at 18°C –

22°C

Weather

We always suggest referring to an online source for the most up-to-date weather information for your destination/s.

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:

Visas

European Union Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaced the manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travellers. Upon arrival in the Schengen

area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10 April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced in 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of these 30 European countries, including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor smartraveller.gov.au closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*

- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
